VOLUNTEERS HELP PACK HUNDREDS OF HAMPERS FOR FAMILIES IN NEED

Requests for Christmas assistance jumped 20% over last year

Wednesday, December 21, 2016 Ottawa — Earlier today, hundreds of volunteers came together to help pack and deliver 500 hampers to those in need in the Ottawa community. These hampers were delivered as part of the Caring and Sharing Exchange's Christmas Exchange program with the generosity of several corporate sponsors.

"We are so grateful to be able to deliver Christmas directly to thousands of those in need in our community," said Cindy Smith, Executive Director of the Caring and Sharing Exchange. Thousands of families have already been helped

In addition to the 500 hampers delivered today, thousands of redeemable gift vouchers have already been mailed out to those in need so that they can purchase items for a festive meal with their loved ones. More than 500 hampers have also been sponsored through the Sponsor-a-Hamper program, **making the grand total more than 1000 HAMPERS delivered through the charity this year alone.**

"There has been a dramatic increase in demand for assistance this year," said Smith. "We are proud to have been able to help nearly as many people this year as we did all of last year, but with Christmas just around the corner **we still have more than 3,000 names left on our waiting list** for assistance."
